

bFan Mark 4 – Addendum

Mark 4

The Mark 4 bFan was launched in February 2022 and is the same as the Mark 3 bFan except that it has a new brushless DC motor that is even quieter and has a larger easier-to-use wireless remote control.

Wireless Remote Control

This remote control is wireless and has 15 speed settings. It also has a timer that will turn the fan off after either 4 or 9 hours. The fan is designed to run at the lower speeds to be quiet so around 3 – 5, adjust it to give the right level of cooling whilst in use. There will be a little bit of noise due to the air flowing through the fan outlet head but so long as the speed is below 5 this should be very low and barely noticeable.



Battery

The remote uses 2 x AAA batteries. We sell the bFan without batteries but include them anyway to get you going but they might not last long. Ensure that they are in as shown here i.e., positive on the left top and then negative for the right top.



Operation

When you press the power button you should hear a bleep and the blue light on the motor should flash briefly. Providing the remote is paired it will then operate the fan.

Pairing & Problems

1. If the remote is dead, ie there are no red light flashes when pressed then first try some new batteries and ensure they are in the right way around as shown.
2. If the red light comes on but nothing happens then it is likely to need pairing with the motor. To do this turn the power on and press and hold your finger on where the blue light is for 10 secs until it bleeps once then twice and starts flashing. Immediately, press the power button on the remote once and it will turn off. It is now paired and should work as normal. For a video of this process please go to www.henleyfan.com/bfan-pair.



3. Check that the mains socket is working and the fuse in the plug. If the motor is still not working then please call our office for assistance.

The remote has a 1-year warranty for non-damage faults. Replacements can be purchased from us.
